4.00PM to 5.30PM: Rest & Relaxation

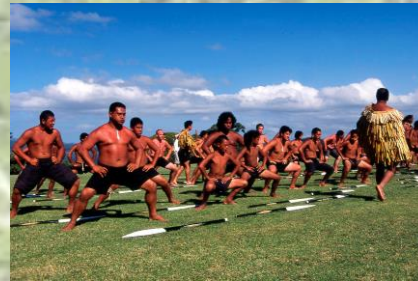
